In 1997 Leslie Morrissette learned firsthand what it was like to spend months at a time in the hospital when her son, Graham, was undergoing cancer treatment in Portland and Boston. Leslie became aware of the need for children to have access to the Internet. It was this need that inspired her to create Grahamtastic Connection. Grahamtastic provides free technology to approximately 150 children each year. The technology includes Laptops, Tablets, Robots and Internet access.
