FOR AUGUST 22: Molly Dunkelburger

20 year-old Molly from Eliot Maine is a cadet at the Airforce Academy who with a small group of her fellow cadets had a private tour of Auschwitz I and II-Birkenau earlier this year, an experience which she said was "extremely heavy, emotional and dense". She is a biology major, with a minor in German. Last summer, she spent a month with a host family in Munich, and went to Salzburg, Austria, and Neuschwanstein Castle in Bavaria. Coincidentally, her tour included Dachau, the Nazi concentration camp near Munich. "But Auschwitz is much more powerful," she said.

The infamous Nazi concentration and death camps are in Oswiecim, 31 miles west of Krakow in southern Poland. Molly said that while Auschwitz I has been cleaned out and contains museum displays, Auschwitz II-Birkenau is left as its liberators found it

Dunkelberger learned of the program from a fellow cadet who told her it changed his life. She applied and learned she was accepted last November. The 14 students were chosen by the Auschwitz Jewish Center Foundation to participate in its American Service Academies Program. The program seeks to teach future military leaders how to "examine history, become ambassadors of ethical behavior and take responsibility for upholding these values," according to the foundation.
