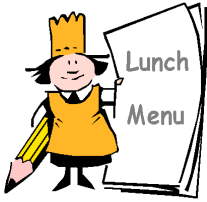
## **Friday, November 2nd**

Author of "My Father's Warm Hands"

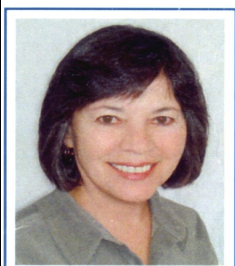

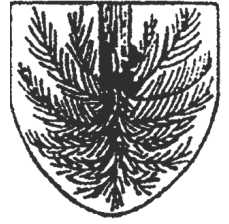
